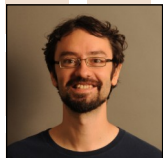
Guru Rao manages software engineering at Fortigent. His interests include agile software development, continuous integration/delivery, automated testing, and human capital management. His hobbies include biking

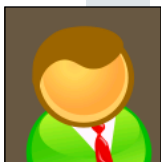
Zach Girod started writing software when he got his first TI-82 graphing calculator. His hobbies include U.S. history, astronomy and running.

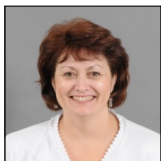
Abhishek Sharma is Sr. Engineer at Fortigent. He believes in smart solutions.
